Whether it be wine tasting, exploring the coastland, indulging in water sports, or meandering around the winding valleys of the local hillside towns, this region has something for everyone.


Many of the small, walled historical towns are worth a visit, many with opulent churches with stunning frescos preserved from the eleventh century.
