Overview

Villa Crysanthe comprises three maisonettes and one apartment, all situated on a secluded private plot. The estate features amenities such as a spacious private swimming pool with a kiosk, barbecue facilities, and expansive garden areas.

The Ground Floor Maisonette includes a large air-conditioned dining and living area, a fully equipped kitchen with modern appliances, and a bathroom with a shower and washing machine. It boasts two double bedrooms.

The Two-Level Maisonette on the ground floor features similar amenities, with additional space on the first level. It includes a queen-size bedroom with a balcony overlooking the pool, another bedroom with two single beds or one king-size bed, and a full bathroom with a shower.

The Apartment, located on the first floor, spans 57m² and accommodates up to three guests with its double bedroom and sofa bed. Villa Crysanthe features a private swimming pool surrounded by manicured gardens and a BBQ area for al fresco dining providing a serene oasis to soak up the Mediterranean sun.
