

Maison d'Argent

Region: Loire Valley Sleeps: 8

Overview

Stay in a beautiful house by the banks of a small river close to the historic market town of Argenton-sur-Creuse. You are only half an hour from Parc naturel régional de la Brenne, a national park said to be one of France's best kept secrets, as well as the landscapes known as the '*Vallée des peintres*'.

With an impressive château towering above and the peaceful river a few steps away, the setting of Maison d'Argent is quite idyllic. The origins of the estate date back to the 12th century and the natural surroundings are gorgeous. Step into your historic home and appreciate its rich character with wood-beamed ceilings, wonderfully tiled floors and classic furnishings alongside modern additions including the stylish contemporary kitchen.

Once a miller's house, open the elegant windows and gaze out to towards the river and woodland – the south-western exposure also means the living spaces are filled with light. The salon is refined yet cosy whilst four double bedrooms have been designed with calming décor, traditional furnishings and lovely bedding, all with modern en suite bathrooms.

Embrace your natural surroundings as you relax by the river. If you feel like holidaying with friends or family, you may also wish to consider neighbouring [Moulin d'Argent](#), a former working watermill. Both houses have access to a canoe and barge for further exploring as well as a pétanque set and some bikes. The estate is home to a spa for a little indulgence on holiday - you can really kick back and relax.

Argenton-sur-Creuse is only 7km by car with its restaurants, shops, cafes and bustling Saturday morning market. Admire charming old townhouses as you stroll along the Creuse River and admire the 19th century mills that once brought the town great wealth.

Visit the historic town of Châteauroux with its vibrant city park and one of France's largest oak forests, then be enchanted by two of France's '*Plus Beaux Villages*', medieval Saint-Benoît-du-Sault and Gargilesse-Dampierre where George Sands once lived. Appreciate many wonderful works of art at Espace Monet Rollinat and Hôtel Lepinat in an area known as the 'valley of the painters'.

Bird-watchers, keen cyclists, walkers and nature enthusiasts will adore the



Parc naturel régional de la Brenne with its landscapes of marshes, marked trails and diverse flora and fauna with over 260 species of birds recorded. L'Étang de Bellebouche is the national park's largest lake and the perfect spot for bird-watching, fishing, kayaking, relaxing on sandy shores and even swimming in the height of the French summer.

Location & Local Information

Less than half an hour south of Châteauroux, the capital of the Indre department in central France, Maison d'Argent sits near the banks of the Bouzanne river next to neighbouring [Moulin d'Argent](#) (ideal if you are two families or friends hoping to travel together yet stay in separate houses). Both houses are surrounded by beautiful shared grounds with riverside access in two different areas – they also both have use of a shared canoe, barge, bikes and pétanque set.

Fly into Bourges, Limoges or Poitiers or the nearest train station is Argenton-sur-Creuse with arrivals from Paris (it's a 2 hours 30 minutes train ride from Gare Austerlitz). If taking the ferry from the UK, Caen Ouistreham/St-Malo/Le Havre are all around a 4 to 5-hour drive away or it is approximately six hours from Calais. Both houses are located just off a country road leading to a small rural village and towards Argenton-sur-Creuse.

Argenton-sur-Creuse (7km) is a small historic town by the banks of the River Creuse, home to several cafes, restaurants and shops as well as a Saturday morning market. It is especially lovely to stroll by the river and admire pretty houses lining the water's edge. The town has a rich heritage in flour, leather and shirt production, industries that brought much wealth in the 1800s. Pass watermills as you explore and learn all about the history of shirt-making at the French-speaking Le Musée de la Chemiserie et de l'Élégance Masculine.

The small city of Châteauroux is worth a visit on a Tuesday, Friday or Saturday morning when the vibrant market takes place. In the summer it's fantastic to visit the city park just north of Châteauroux with fitness trails, a play area and a recreational lake for summer swimming, canoeing, kayaking, stand-up paddle boarding and more. Just outside the city, look out for wonderful nature trails through the magnificent Châteauroux forest, one of the country's largest oak forests (many Bordeaux wine barrels are made from Châteauroux oak).

Venturing south, Saint-Benoît-du-Sault (27km) is such a picturesque village with medieval houses, half-timbered buildings and old lanes – it's classified as one of France's '*Plus Beaux Villages*'. Gargilesse-Dampierre (20km) is another '*Plus Beau Village*' in a riverside setting with historic houses, an impressive château and the former home of George Sands where she wrote much of her work.

Outdoor lovers will appreciate being only half an hour from the superb Parc naturel régional de la Brenne with its varied landscapes of marshes and fields. Start off at Maison du Parc in Rosnay (34km) to pick up maps, then start exploring the scenery by walking or cycling following kilometres of marked



trails. Look out for summer swimming and a children's play area at Étang de Bellebouche. This incredible area is ideal for outdoor explorers of every age as well as wildlife enthusiasts and bird-watchers.

Meanwhile, learn how the beautiful landscapes of this region inspired so many artists – heading south is Espace Monet Rollinat (40km), an art museum and gallery in Fresselines, an area known as the 'valley of the painters'.

Furthermore, don't miss the wonderful exhibitions at the art museum, Hôtel Lepinat (37km).

- [Moulin d'Argent](#) and Maison d'Argent share the grounds surrounding the two properties with riverside access. Both properties share use of a canoe, barge, bikes and pétanque set.
